



Termites/Mites on Ice Program

The 2008-09 hockey season is underway and the Nashville Predators want your team to play on the Preds home ice at the Sommet Center! That's right you can play on the same ice as the pros! Thousands of youth & adult hockey players have skated on the very same ice as the NHL players since the Predators 1998-99 inaugural season.

Let us simulate an NHL game day experience for you and your team with *Termites/Mites on Ice!* Teams ages 9-and-under have the opportunity to skate in front of 17,000+ fans during the 1st intermission of select Predators home games. Each experience is limited to 2 teams (or the equivalent of up to 30 skaters). On top of everything else, your team will be able to stick around to cheer on the Preds as they take on top teams in the NHL!

What comes with Termites/Mites On Ice?

- Opportunity to attend a Nashville Predators home game
- 3-minute shootout during the 1st intermission at a select Preds home game
- Up to 2 teams or equivalent of up to 30 skaters eligible
- Video scoreboard welcome
- Access to changing room area
- Fundraising opportunity

Team information:

- Each team is required to sell fifty tickets in order to participate.
- Ticket orders placed through the provided Termites/Mites on Ice order form will be provided **to the team managers** to distribute to participants and families **the week prior to the game.**
- Teams **arrive at the Sommet Center 1 hour and 15 minutes** prior to Preds puck drop (ex: 7:00pm puck drop, arrive at 5:45pm). We suggest **Dressing participants in bottom half of equipment** (shin guards, socks, hockey pants) upon arrival.
- Teams **enter the Sommet Center via the South Entrance** located on Demonbreun and 5th Avenue adjacent to the Country Music Hall of Fame.
- All **individuals required to have an event ticket** in their hand to be scanned to enter the arena.
- Teams will be led by game night staff to elevators outside section 108/109 to drop off equipment.
- Game night staff will meet teams **outside section 108/109 at 15:00 left on the clock in the 1st period** to escort teams to changing area on the Event Level.
- Only **designated team staff (coaches, team managers, etc.) and players will be granted access to Event Level,** changing area and on-ice. All coaches must wear skates, no shoes permitted on ice.
- After on-ice scrimmage, participants will change and be **escorted back to the Concourse Level to meet parents and drop off equipment by the elevators outside section 108/109.**
- Teams may **pick up equipment anytime after 1st intermission,** but must pick up equipment immediately following the end of the Preds game.

Waivers:

- On event day, **each child and on-ice coach MUST have a completed waiver form** signed by a parent or legal guardian in order to participate.

Camera/Video Recorders:

- Spectators are allowed to bring personal cameras; however no professional recording or camera is permitted in the Sommet Center during Preds games.
